### **Partridgeberry Cheesecake \$7.00**

Partridgeberry (*Vaccinium vitis-idaea*) - Internationally known as the lingonberry, this relative of the cranberry family is a low mat forming evergreen shrub with tiny rounded leaves. These berries grow in the dry, acidic soils of Newfoundland and Labrador's barrens and coastal headlands.



### **Bakeapple Cheesecake \$7.00**

Cloudberry (*Rubus Chamaemorus*) – “Bakeapple”, anglicized from the French, ‘baie qu’appelle’ meaning, “what is this berry called..?”, is internationally known as a Cloudberry.
